

## **Appendix to the application**

This application form is to be used when submitting an application for ethical vetting in accordance with The Act concerning the Ethical Review of Research Involving Humans (2003:460). It is intended to be used for all types of research where approval is to be sought from an ethical review board. The form is also to be used when a request is made for an advisory statement in accordance with section 4a and 4b of the Statute (2003:615) concerning the Ethical Review of Research Involving Humans. Depending upon what research the application concerns, the information asked for below will have various degrees of relevance. As a result, the requirement of completeness will also vary when it comes to detailing them. Mark on the form when the information does not concern the project in question. The application is to be completed in an easily legible manner. It is not to be written by hand, nor using a small font and close spacing. The Swedish language is to be used to complete the form. The annex for professional experts as described in p. 2:1 may be written in English.

Please note that an application is never complete (and thus able to be processed) until the form is correctly filled in and the fee has been paid.

***The application and annexes should be submitted as one original document together with 17 copies!***

### **Concerning this form**

All the fields to be filled in are shaded grey. Additional explanatory text is fixed and must not be altered. The grey fields expand to accommodate any text entered. The space available is therefore unlimited. Please note that reference can be made to the detailed research plan appended. When printed out, only the text you have entered is visible and not the grey fields visible on the screen. It is therefore extremely important to check that everything really has been filled in completely. When you have finished, print out the form, add the necessary signatures and annexes and send it to the Regional Ethical Review Board for the catchment area to which the entity principally responsible for the research belongs.
